description continued

windows similar to first and second stories, but smaller, terra cotta sill course above entablature; two fixed windows over entry separated by large panel with chemistry motif. terra cotta cornice forms window lintels. two large capped central ridge chimneys.

west facade - 3 bays. high basement foundation without windows. similar details as main facade. large metal open fire escape with platforms and double door entries in center of second and attic stories.

east facade - identical to west with fire escape entry on first story, also. below grade basement entry with flanking sash.

south facade - "T" plan. 7 bays on each arm. center stem connects with Davenport Hall (#001). entry in west end bay similar to east facade secondary entry. west side stem connection with recessed double doors with Art Deco decoration, concrete surround with stylized zigzags and hanging metal lamp with scrolled metal backdrop. east side stem connection with basement recessed double door entry.
